## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and One.

### AN ACT

Making Appropriations for the Payment of Annuities  
to Soldiers and Others.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned  
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury  
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,  
4 for the payment of annuities and pensions due  
5 from the Commonwealth, to soldiers and others,  
6 during the year ending on the thirty-first day of  
7 December in the year nineteen hundred and one,  
8 to wit: —

9 For annuities due from the Commonwealth, in-  
10 curred by the acceptance of the bequest of the  
11 late Martha Johonnot, a sum not exceeding two  
12 hundred dollars. [Res. 1841, chap. 65; 1843,  
13 chap. 73.]

(Appropriation 1900, \$200.)

14 For annuities to soldiers and others, as author-  
15 ized by the legislature, the sum of five thousand

16 nine hundred and eighty dollars. [Res. 1874,  
17 chap. 83; 1876, chap. 14; 1885, chap. 41; 1887,  
18 chap. 83; 1889, chap. 52; 1891, chap. 34; 1892,  
19 chaps. 8 and 102; 1893, chaps. 13 and 41; 1895,  
20 chap. 14; 1896, chaps. 8, 9, 10, 28 and 64; 1897,  
21 chaps. 9 and 96; 1898, chaps. 11, 21 and 42;  
22 1899, chaps. 6, 10, 77 and 92; 1900, chap. 89.]

23 For pensions authorized by the legislature, the  
24 sum of five hundred and twenty dollars. [Res.  
25 1869; chap. 83; 1870, chap. 64; 1873, chap. 63.]

(Appropriation 1900, \$520.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
