AN ACT

To provide for Sanitary Accommodations at Street
Railway Stations.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Every street railway company
2 in this Commonwealth shall provide suitable
3 sanitary accommodations for its passengers at all
4 stations or waiting-rooms for passengers, main-
5 tained by such company.

1 SECTION 2. The said accommodations shall
2 be constructed and maintained in such a manner
3 as shall be approved by the board of health of the
4 city or town in which they shall be situated.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon the
2 first day of September in the year nineteen hun-
3 dred and one.
