

# HOUSE . . . . . No. 113.

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[Bill accompanying the petition of John Woodbury, secretary, for legislation to increase the amount of money to be placed at the disposal of the Metropolitan Park Commission for Nantasket Beach. Metropolitan Affairs. January 11.]

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## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and One.

### AN ACT

To increase the amount of Money to be placed at the Disposal of the Metropolitan Park Commission for Nantasket Beach.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan park commis-  
2 sion, created by chapter four hundred and seven  
3 of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and  
4 ninety-three, for the purpose of carrying out the  
5 provisions of chapter four hundred and sixty-four  
6 of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and  
7 ninety-nine, may expend an additional sum of one  
8 hundred thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. To meet any expenditure made  
2 under the authority of this act the treasurer and  
3 receiver-general shall issue scrip or certificates of  
4 indebtedness or bonds as an addition to the Met-  
5 ropolitan Parks Loan. The sinking fund al-  
6 ready established by law shall also be maintained  
7 for the purpose of extinguishing scrip, certificates  
8 or bonds issued under the authority of this act.  
9 Any premium realized on the sale of said scrip,  
10 certificates or bonds shall be applied to the pay-  
11 ment of the interest on the loan hereby author-  
12 ized as it accrues. Said scrip, certificates or  
13 bonds shall be issued and said sinking fund as-  
14 sessed and collected in accordance with the pro-  
15 visions of chapter four hundred and seven of the  
16 acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-  
17 three, chapter two hundred and eighty-three of  
18 the acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-  
19 five, and chapter four hundred and nineteen of  
20 the acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-  
21 nine: *provided, however,* that for the purpose of  
22 meeting the sinking fund and interest require-  
23 ments for the loan authorized by this act, and to  
24 provide for the care and maintenance of the res-  
25 ervation taken under the authority of said chap-  
26 ter four hundred and sixty-four of the acts of the  
27 year eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, the town  
28 of Cohasset shall be deemed and treated as a part  
29 of the metropolitan parks district, in the same  
30 manner and to the same extent as the cities and  
31 towns named in section three of chapter four hun-  
32 dred and seven of the acts of the year eighteen

33 hundred and ninety-three; and the commissioners  
34 appointed by the supreme judicial court to fix the  
35 proportion in which the cities and towns of the  
36 district shall annually pay into the treasury of  
37 the Commonwealth to meet said sinking fund and  
38 interest requirements and cost of care and main-  
39 tenance shall in like manner determine the pro-  
40 portion to be paid by said town of Cohasset; and  
41 the treasurer of the Commonwealth shall annually  
42 estimate the amount required for that purpose in  
43 accordance with the proportion determined as  
44 aforesaid, and shall each year include the same as  
45 a part of the state tax of said town of Cohasset.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
