

HOUSE No. 165.

[Bill accompanying the petition of Henry E. Madden and others for legislation to authorize the town of Medway to refund a sum of money paid by Lawrence McGinnis for a liquor license, which license was revoked by the district court of Western Norfolk, and to authorize the Commonwealth to refund a proportional part of said money to said town. Liquor Law. January 17.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and One.

AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Medway to refund a Sum of Money paid by Lawrence McGinnis for a Liquor License, and to authorize the Commonwealth to reimburse said Town.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The town of Medway is hereby
2 authorized and empowered to pay to Lawrence
3 McGinnis the sum of twenty-three hundred dol-
4 lars, being the sum paid by said McGinnis to said
5 town for licenses granted to him by the select-

6 men of said town to sell intoxicating liquors for
7 the year beginning the first of May eighteen hun-
8 dred and ninety-nine, and which licenses were
9 revoked and annulled by the district court of
10 western Norfolk on or about the twenty-first day
11 of said May.

1 SECTION 2. The treasurer and receiver gen-
2 eral is directed to pay to the town of Medway the
3 sum paid by said town into the treasury of the
4 Commonwealth from the proceeds of licenses
5 granted to Lawrence McGinnis for the sale of
6 intoxicating liquors as stated in section one of
7 this act.
