AN ACT

Relative to Clerical Assistance in the Office of the
Tax Commissioner and Commissioner of Corpora-
tions.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section one of chapter three hun-
2 dred forty-two of the acts of the year eighteen
3 hundred and ninety-one is hereby amended by
4 inserting in place of the word "sixteen," in the
5 fifth line, the word : — eighteen, — so as to read
6 as follows :

7 *Section 1.* The tax commissioner and commis-
8 sioner of corporations may employ in his office
9 such additional clerks and other assistance as
10 may be necessary for the despatch of public bus-
11 iness, at an expense not exceeding eighteen thou-
12 sand dollars a year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
