### AN ACT

#### Relative to the sale of Liquor by Innholders.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section nine, clause second, of  
2 chapter one hundred of the Public Statutes, as  
3 amended by section one of chapter ninety of the  
4 acts of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-  
5 five, is hereby amended by striking out the whole  
6 of said clause and inserting in place thereof the  
7 following:—Second, that no sale of spirituous or  
8 intoxicating liquor shall be made between the  
9 hours of eleven at night and six in the morning,  
10 nor during the Lord's day, except that if the  
11 licensee is also licensed as an innholder he may

12 supply such liquor on any day of the week be-  
13 tween the hours of six in the morning and twelve  
14 midnight, to guests who have resorted to his  
15 house for food or lodging.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
