### RESOLVE

In Favor of John Martin.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the  
2 treasury of the Commonwealth the sum of one hundred  
3 and twenty-five dollars to John Martin, who served in  
4 the United States army during the war of the rebellion,  
5 to the credit of the town of Grafton, and who never re-  
6 ceived a bounty for such service. The said Martin was  
7 a member of company G, twentieth regiment, Massachu-  
8 setts volunteers.
