AN ACT

Relative to the Board of Overseers of Harvard
College.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The president and fellows of Har-
2 vard college and the board of overseers of said
3 college, acting separately at meetings called for
4 that purpose, may determine from time to time by
5 concurrent vote whether any, and, if any, what
6 degrees issued by said college other than those
7 mentioned in the first section of chapter one hun-
8 dred and seventy-three of the acts of the year
9 eighteen hundred and sixty-five, shall entitle the
10 recipients thereof to vote for overseers to the
11 same extent and under the same restrictions to

12 and under which recipients of the degree of
13 bachelor of arts from said college may now so
14 vote.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be in force when
2 the board of overseers and the president and
3 fellows of Harvard college respectively, at meet-
4 ings held for that purpose, shall by vote have
5 assented to the same.
