### AN ACT

#### Making Appropriations for the Experiment Station at the Massachusetts Agricultural College.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned  
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury  
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,  
4 for the purposes specified, to meet expenses for  
5 the year ending on the thirty-first day of December  
6 nineteen hundred and one, to wit: —

7 For maintaining an agricultural experiment sta-  
8 tion at the Massachusetts agricultural college, the  
9 sum of ten thousand dollars. [Acts 1882, chap.  
10 212; 1885, chap. 327.]

(Appropriation 1900, \$10,000.)

11 To defray the expenses of collecting and anal-  
12 yzing samples of concentrated commercial feed  
13 stuffs, as provided for by chapter one hundred and  
14 seventeen of the acts of the year eighteen hundred  
15 and ninety-seven, twelve hundred dollars.

(Appropriation 1900, \$1,200.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
