Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and One.

AN ACT

To authorize the Citizens' Electric Street Railway Company to act as a Common Carrier of Certain Merchandise and to carry the United States Mail.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The Citizens' Electric Street  
2 Railway Company is hereby authorized and em-  
3 powered to act as a common carrier of coal,  
4 market produce, provisions, ice, baggage and  
5 building materials, over its tracks in the city of  
6 Newburyport and the town of Newbury, and also  
7 is authorized to carry the United States mails  
8 over its entire system.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
