

HOUSE No. 464.

[Resolve accompanying the petition of William S. Greene and others for legislation to provide an appropriation for new buildings and for maintenance at the Fall River Textile School. Education. Jan 30.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and One.

RESOLVE

In favor of the Fall River Textile School.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth to the trustees of the Fall
3 River Textile School, the sum of eighteen thousand
4 dollars to be applied to the purposes of said school: *pro-*
5 *vided*, that no part of this sum shall be paid until satis-
6 factory evidence is furnished to the auditor of accounts
7 of the Commonwealth that an additional sum of seven
8 thousand dollars has been paid to said trustees by the
9 city of Fall River or received by them from other sources.
10 The city of Fall River is hereby authorized to raise by
11 taxation and pay to said trustees such sum of money,
12 not exceeding seven thousand dollars, as may be neces-
13 sary, together with that received from other sources, to
14 secure the amount provided for by this resolve.

15 That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of
16 the Commonwealth to the aforesaid trustees the further
17 sum of fifty thousand dollars to be expended under the
18 direction of said trustees to complete the erection and
19 equipment of a building or buildings for the use of said
20 school.
