[Bill accompanying the petition of John Woodbury, secretary for legislation to define the manner in which public notice shall be given of the rules and regulations adopted by the Metropolitan Park Commission for the government and use of parks and parkways in the metropolitan park system.]

AN ACT

To amend Section Seven of Chapter Four Hundred and Fifty of the Acts of the Year Eighteen Hundred and Ninety-Five relative to Metropolitan Parks.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section seven of chapter four
2 hundred and fifty of the acts of the year eighteen
3 hundred and ninety-five is hereby amended by
4 striking out the whole of said section and substi-
5 tuting in the place thereof the following: —

6 *Section 7.* Said commission shall cause the
7 rules and regulations made by it from time to time

8 to be posted in the reservation or parkway to
9 which they apply and shall also cause the same to
10 be published at least three times in one or more
11 newspapers published in the county within which
12 said reservation or parkway is in whole or in part
13 located, and such posting and publication shall be
14 sufficient notice to all persons. The sworn certifi-
15 cate of any member of said commission or of its
16 secretary that said rules and regulations have
17 been posted and published as herein provided,
18 shall be prima facie evidence thereof. A copy of
19 said rules and regulations, attested by any mem-
20 ber of said commission or by its secretary, shall
21 be prima facie evidence that said rules and regu-
22 lations have been made by said commission, as
23 provided by law.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
