### AN ACT

Relative to Fire Department Employees in Certain Cities.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The employees of the fire department in  
2 all cities having a population of forty thousand or more  
3 shall receive one full day's vacation in every eight days,  
4 without loss of pay, in addition to any annual vacation  
5 now or hereafter granted to such employees.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on the first day  
2 of January in the year nineteen hundred and two.
