In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and One.

AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Running Expenses of the Steamer Lexington.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. A sum not exceeding nine thousand dol-
2 lars is hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the treas-
3 ury of the Commonwealth from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the running expenses of the steamer Lexington to be
5 used under the charge of the chief of the district police
6 for the enforcement of the fish laws, for the year ending
7 on the thirty-first day of December in the year nineteen
8 hundred and one.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
