RESOLVE

In favor of James F. Walsh.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth to James F. Walsh of
3 Brockton, father of Joseph F. Walsh, late a sailor in the
4 naval service of the United States, who was killed by the
5 blowing up of the "Maine" in Havana harbor, February
6 fifteen, eighteen hundred and ninety-eight, the sum to
7 which the said James F. Walsh would be entitled under
8 chapter five hundred and sixty-one of the acts of the year
9 eighteen hundred and ninety-eight, as amended by chap-
10 ter four hundred and seventy-one of the acts of the year
11 eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, if his said son had
12 been mustered into the said service between the fourteenth
13 day of February, eighteen hundred and ninety-eight, and
14 the first day of January, eighteen hundred and ninety-
15 nine, and had been killed in the Spanish war.
