AN ACT

Making Appropriations for Salaries and Expenses at the Lyman School for Boys.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the purposes specified, to meet expenses for
5 the year ending on the thirty-first day of Decem-
6 ber, nineteen hundred and one, to wit: —

7 For the payment of salaries, wages and labor
8 at the Lyman school for boys, a sum not exceed-
9 ing twenty-nine thousand six hundred dollars.

(Appropriation 1900, \$28,300.)

11 For current expenses at the Lyman school for
12 boys, a sum not exceeding forty-five thousand
13 four hundred and ten dollars. [Pub. Stats., chap.
14 89.]

(Appropriation 1900, \$41,535.)

15 For salaries and expenses of such agents as the
16 trustees of the Lyman and industrial schools may
17 deem necessary to employ, a sum not exceeding
18 seven thousand five hundred dollars. [Acts 1895,
19 chap. 428.]

(Appropriation 1900, \$7,500.)

20 For expenses in connection with boarding-out
21 children by the trustees of the Lyman and indus-
22 trial schools, a sum not exceeding five thousand
23 five hundred dollars. [Acts 1895, chap. 428.]

(Appropriation 1900, \$5,500.)

24 For the education and instruction in the public
25 schools in any city or town in the Commonwealth
26 of children boarded or bound out by the trustees
27 of the Lyman and industrial schools, a sum not
28 exceeding five hundred dollars. [Acts 1896,
29 chap. 382.]

(Appropriation 1900, \$500.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
