

HOUSE No. 765.

[Bill accompanying the petition of F. A. Hosmer and others for legislation to incorporate the Middlesex West Agricultural Society. Agriculture. Feb. 4.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and One.

AN ACT

To incorporate the Middlesex West Agricultural Society.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. F. A. Hosmer, L. E. Fletcher, J.
2 E. Nixon, J. P. Thatcher, Charles F. Watts,
3 Elmer W. Fletcher, James W. Ireland, W. H.
4 Davis, J. H. D. Whitcomb and Frank A. Patch
5 of the towns of Littleton and Boxborough, their
6 associates and successors, are hereby made a cor-
7 poration under the name of the Middlesex West
8 Agricultural Society, established in the town of
9 Littleton in the county of Middlesex, for the
10 encouragement of agriculture, horticulture and

11 the arts by premiums and other means, with all
12 the powers, privileges and benefits now accruing
13 to county societies, and subject to all duties,
14 liabilities and restrictions as set forth in all gen-
15 eral laws which are now or hereafter may be in
16 force in relation to such corporations. Said cor-
17 poration may hold by purchase, gift, devise or
18 otherwise real and personal property to an amount
19 not exceeding ten thousand dollars.

1 SECTION 2. The charter of any regularly in-
2 corporated agricultural society not holding fairs
3 and not represented on the state board of agricult-
4 ure, which conflicts with the territory of the said
5 Middlesex West Agricultural Society, in whole
6 or in part, is hereby annulled.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
