AN ACT

Relative to the Disposition of Fees received for Licenses for the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section fourteen of chapter one
2 hundred of the Public Statutes is hereby amended
3 by striking out the word "one-fourth," in the
4 second line thereof, and inserting in its place
5 the following words:— and to the treasurer of
6 the county in which such municipality is situated
7 each one-half,— so that said section as amended
8 shall read as follows:—

9 *Section 14.* The treasurer of a city or town
10 shall pay to the treasurer of the Commonwealth
11 and to the treasurer of the county in which such
12 municipality is situated, each, one-half of all
13 moneys received by him for licenses, within one
14 month after he receives the same.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
