### AN ACT

To regulate the Sale and Price of Electricity in Boston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Every company furnishing electricity for lighting  
2 purposes to consumers in the city of Boston shall be  
3 required to furnish it to such consumers at a price not  
4 exceeding one quarter of a cent per light of sixteen  
5 candle power for one hour. Any company which  
6 collects of any consumer or charges to any consumer a  
7 larger sum than the maximum specified in this act shall  
8 be fined not less than fifty dollars and not more than five  
9 hundred dollars for each offence.
