Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and One.

AN ACT

Relative to the Publication of Public Documents.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The various departments of the  
2 Commonwealth, authorized to print public docu-  
3 ments and reports, shall print without special  
4 leave the customary annual reports and docu-  
5 ments.

1 SECTION 2. Any extended or unusual publi-  
2 cation shall be done only when specially author-  
3 ized by law, or when the scope and general plan  
4 of such publication has been submitted to a board  
5 of supervisors of statistics, and approved by them.  
6 Nor shall it be undertaken unless an appropri-  
7 ation therefor has been made.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
