AN ACT

Relative to Jury Trials in Certain Cases of Appeals
from the Probate Courts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. In all appeals from the findings
2 of the probate court either party affected by the
3 decision thereof may within ten days from the
4 entry of such appeals in the supreme judicial
5 or superior court claim a trial by jury upon
6 issues duly framed.

1 SECTION 2. All acts inconsistent herewith
2 are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon
2 its passage.
