[Bill accompanying the petition of James P. Ramsay and others for legislation to require the civil service commissioners to post lists of the names of persons certified for appointment to the public service. Public Service. Feb. 4.]

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and One.

AN ACT

Relative to posting Lists of Names of Persons certified for Appointment by the Civil Service Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section four of chapter five hun-
2 dred and seventeen of the acts of the year eighteen
3 hundred and ninety-six is hereby amended by
4 striking out the words "a list," in the eighth line,
5 and inserting in place thereof the word:— lists;
6 also by striking out all after the words "shall be,"
7 in the ninth line, and inserting in place thereof

8 the words:— posted in a conspicuous place in
9 the post-office or in the city or town hall, or in
10 both such places,— so as to read as follows:—

11 *Section 4.* The civil service commissioners,
12 within five days after the final markings upon
13 any examination of applicants for positions in the
14 public service, shall cause a list of the names of
15 applicants passing the examination to be pre-
16 pared, showing the standing of each obtained in
17 the examination; they shall also, within five days
18 of any certification of persons for appointments
19 or employment, cause lists of the names of the
20 persons so certified to be prepared, and said lists
21 shall be posted in a conspicuous place in the post-
22 office or in the city or town hall, or in both such
23 places.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
