In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and One.

AN ACT

To authorize the Northampton and Amherst Street Railway Company to manufacture and sell Electricity for Light and Power.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Northampton and Amherst
2 Street Railway Company is hereby authorized,
3 upon the approval of the board of gas and elec-
4 tric light commissioners, to carry on the business
5 of manufacturing and selling electricity for light
6 and power in the towns of Hadley, Hatfield,
7 Whately and Deerfield, and in that part of
8 Northampton known as Laurel park, with all the

9 rights, powers and privileges and subject to all
10 the duties, liabilities and restrictions now or here-
11 after conferred or imposed by law upon such
12 corporations.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
