AN ACT

To authorize the United States Hotel Company to hold Additional Property and to increase its Capital Stock.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The United States Hotel Com-
2 pany, a corporation established under the name
3 of the Proprietors of the City Hotel in Boston,
4 by chapter one hundred and three of the acts of
5 the year eighteen hundred and twenty-four, may
6 hold property for the purposes now granted to it
7 by law to an amount not exceeding two million
8 dollars.

1 SECTION 2. Subject to the provisions of the
2 general laws relating to corporations, it may in-
3 crease its capital stock to an amount not exceed-
4 ing two million dollars, such increase to be made
5 only under the direction and with the approval of
6 the commissioner of corporations.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
