RESOLVE

To provide for the Purchase of Land and for Certain Improvements at the Massachusetts Hospital for Dipso-
maniacs and Inebriates.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding
3 three thousand five hundred fifty dollars to be expended
4 at the Massachusetts hospital for dipsomaniacs and
5 inebriates under the direction of the trustees thereof for
6 the following purposes:—For the construction of a
7 building for workshops a sum not exceeding two thou-
8 sand five hundred dollars; for an addition to the piggery
9 a sum not exceeding six hundred dollars; for the pur-
10 chase of land a sum not exceeding four hundred fifty
11 dollars.
