AN ACT

Relative to Fire Department Employees in Certain Cities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The employees of the fire depart-
2 ment in all cities shall receive one full day's
3 vacation in every eight days, without loss of pay,
4 in addition to any annual vacation now or here-
5 after granted to such employees.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall be submitted to the
2 voters of every city at the next annual municipal
3 election, and shall take effect upon its acceptance
4 by a majority of the voters in any city.
