### AN ACT

To establish the Salary of the Clerk of the First District Court of Bristol.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The salary of the clerk of the first  
2 district court of Bristol shall be thirteen hundred  
3 dollars a year, to be so allowed from the first day  
4 of July in the year nineteen hundred and one.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
