### AN ACT

In addition to an Act Making Appropriations for Deficiencies in Appropriations for Certain Expenses authorized in the Year Nineteen Hundred.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned  
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury  
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,  
4 for certain expenses in excess of appropriations  
5 authorized in the year nineteen hundred, to wit:—

6 For incidental and contingent expenses in the  
7 adjutant general's department, the sum of one  
8 hundred and forty-two dollars and sixty cents.

9 For incidental and contingent expenses in the  
10 quartermaster general's department, the sum of  
11 one hundred sixty-six dollars and thirty-nine  
12 cents.

13 For expenses in connection with military ac-

14 counts not otherwise provided for, the sum of  
15 twenty-three dollars and sixty-three cents.

16 For compensation of officers and men of the  
17 volunteer militia, the sum of six hundred and  
18 twenty-three dollars.

19 For transportation of officers and men of the  
20 volunteer militia when on military duty, the sum  
21 of two hundred sixty dollars and eight cents.

22 For expenses in connection with the finishing  
23 and furnishing of certain buildings at the Lyman  
24 school for boys, the sum of thirteen hundred  
25 eight dollars and twenty-five cents, the same to  
26 be paid out of the appropriation for current ex-  
27 penses of the present year.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
