AN ACT

To amend the Act requiring Bonds to be given under Certain Contracts made by the Metropolitan Water and Sewerage Board.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter three hundred and thirty-nine of the
2 acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-
3 seven is hereby amended by inserting at the end
4 thereof the following: "Nothing herein con-
5 tained shall be construed to deprive any city or
6 town of any rights or remedies under laws exist-
7 ing at the time of the passage of this act."
