In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and One.

AN ACT

To require Railroad Companies to issue Five Hundred Mile Mileage Books at the Rate of Two Cents a Mile.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Every railroad corporation oper-
2 ating upon tracks of standard gauge shall issue
3 upon demand five hundred mile mileage books at
4 the rate of two cents a mile.

1 SECTION 2. Every railroad corporation subject
2 to the provisions of this act shall post a copy of
3 this act, printed in such type as to be easily dis-
4 tinguishable, on or above the ticket window or

5 windows of every station of its road for a period
6 of one year; and every railroad corporation shall
7 for a period of six months cause to be inserted in
8 every newspaper in which its time-tables do ap-
9 pear, in easily distinguishable type, a statement
10 to the effect that five hundred mile mileage books
11 may be obtained for the sum of ten dollars at the
12 several ticket offices of the company.
