AN ACT

Relative to the Annual Expenditures of the Board of Gas and Electric Light Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 2 light commissioners may expend a sum not ex-
- 3 ceeding three thousand dollars annually in pro-
- 4 curing statistics, books and stationery, and for
