AN ACT

Relative to the Annual Expenditures of the Board of Gas and Electric Light Commissioners.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The board of gas and electric
2 light commissioners may expend a sum not ex-
3 ceeding three thousand dollars annually in pro-
4 curing statistics, books and stationery, and for
5 other necessary incidental expenses. They may
6 also expend a sum not exceeding forty-one hun-
7 dred dollars annually for clerical assistance. The
8 amounts expended under this section shall be
9 assessed and collected as is now provided by

10 law for the assessment and collection of the other
11 expenses of said board.

1 SECTION 2. Section one of chapter three hun-
2 dred and sixty-five of the acts of the year eigh-
3 teen hundred and ninety-nine is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
