AN ACT

Relative to the Construction of the Cambridge Street Subway and East Boston Tunnel by the Boston Transit Commission.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of chapter five
2 hundred of the acts of the year eighteen hundred
3 and ninety-seven relating to the construction of a
4 subway under Cambridge street and a tunnel to
5 East Boston are hereby extended so that the
6 Cambridge street subway and the East Boston
7 tunnel may, with the consent of the Boston
8 Elevated Railway Company, be connected with
9 the existing subway and with each other at such
10 points and in such manner, whether at grade or
11 otherwise, as the commission may deem that the
12 public interests require.

1 SECTION 2. In the work of constructing the
2 Cambridge street subway and the East Boston

3 tunnel the Boston transit commission shall have
4 all the powers vested in it by chapter five hun-
5 dred and forty-eight of the acts of the year
6 eighteen hundred and ninety-four and by acts in
7 amendment thereof and in addition thereto.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
