### AN ACT

To provide for the Appointment of a Messenger for the Probate Court and Court of Insolvency for the County of Middlesex.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The judges of probate and insol-  
2 vency, for the county of Middlesex, may appoint  
3 a messenger for the courts of probate and insol-  
4 vency for that county, who shall wait upon said  
5 courts and perform such duties as said judges  
6 may direct.

1 SECTION 2. Such messenger shall receive an  
2 annual salary of            dollars, payable monthly.

1 SECTION 3. The judges of said court may at  
2 any time remove said messenger for cause deemed  
3 by them sufficient, and may fill the vacancy  
4 caused by such removal or otherwise.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
