

[To accompany the petition of the Provident Institution for Savings in the town of Boston and the Suffolk Savings Bank for Seamen and Others, that savings banks and institutions for savings may be exempted from the provisions of law requiring notice to the treasurer and receiver-general before payment of deposits to the estates of deceased non-residents.

AN ACT

To exempt Savings Banks and Institutions for Savings from the Provisions of Chapter Three Hundred and Seventy-one of the Acts of Nineteen Hundred.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The provisions of chapter three
2 hundred and seventy-one of the acts of nineteen
3 hundred shall not apply to the payment, to the
4 estates of deceased non-residents, of deposits in
5 savings banks or institutions for savings.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
