### AN ACT

To authorize the Trustees of Tufts College to hold  
Additional Real and Personal Estate.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section one of chapter one hun-  
2 dred and sixty-two of the year eighteen hundred  
3 and eighty-six is hereby amended so as to read as  
4 follows:— Said corporation shall be capable of  
5 taking and holding in fee simple or any less estate,  
6 by gift, grant, bequest, devise, or otherwise, for  
7 the further endowment of said college any lands,  
8 tenements, or other estate, real or personal.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
