Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and One.

AN ACT

To establish the Second District Court of East
Norfolk.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The towns of Braintree, Wey-
2 mouth, Cohasset, Holbrook and Randolph shall
3 constitute a judicial district under the jurisdiction
4 of a court to be called the second district court of
5 East Norfolk. Said court shall be held in the
6 town of Braintree.

1 SECTION 2. There shall be one justice, two
2 special justices and a clerk of said court. The
3 justice shall receive an annual salary of fifteen

4 hundred dollars, and the clerk an annual salary
5 of eight hundred dollars, to be paid by the county
6 of Norfolk. All provisions of law applicable to
7 district courts shall apply to said court.

1 SECTION 3. The first session of said court
2 shall be held on the first day of June in the year
3 nineteen hundred and one, but nothing in this act
4 shall affect any suit or other proceedings begun
5 prior to said first day of June.

1 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
