—RESOLVE—

To provide for certain Improvements at the State Hospital.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding
3 fifty-one thousand two hundred eighty-eight dollars, to
4 be expended at the state hospital under the direction of
5 the trustees thereof for the following purposes:— For
6 furnishing, heating and lighting the new asylum building,
7 a sum not exceeding ten thousand dollars; for concreting
8 walks, a sum not exceeding one thousand five hundred
9 dollars; for a spur track, a sum not exceeding four
10 thousand dollars; for the purchase of land, a sum not
11 exceeding five thousand dollars; for rebuilding a dormi-
12 tory, a sum not exceeding ten thousand dollars; for
13 reimbursing officers and Lowell fire department, a sum
14 not exceeding seven hundred eighty-eight dollars; and
15 for water supply, a sum not exceeding twenty thousand
16 dollars.
