### AN ACT

Relative to Uniforms for Messengers in the Superior Court in the Counties of Suffolk and Middlesex.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section seventy-seven of chapter  
2 one hundred and sixty-five of the Revised Laws  
3 is hereby amended by adding after the word  
4 "sheriffs," in the second line thereof, the words: ~~and~~  
5 and messengers, — so as to read as follows: —  
6 Section 77. The officers named in sections  
7 sixty-nine, seventy-three and seventy-six and  
8 deputy sheriffs and messengers in attendance  
9 upon the supreme judicial court or the superior

10 court in the county of Suffolk or Middlesex shall,  
11 while on duty in said courts, wear uniforms which  
12 shall be designated by the sheriff of the county  
13 and, except the deputy sheriffs in the county of  
14 Middlesex, shall each be annually allowed by the  
15 respective counties one hundred dollars in addi-  
16 tion to the salary allowed by law in order to pro-  
17 vide such uniforms.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
