AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the State House Loans Sinking Fund.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sum of ninety thousand three
2 hundred seven dollars and thirty-six cents is
3 hereby appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury
4 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
5 for the State House Loans Sinking Fund, as pro-
6 vided for by chapter thirty-nine of the acts of the
7 year eighteen hundred and ninety-five, said sum
8 being the estimate of the treasurer and receiver-
9 general.

(No appropriation 1901.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
