In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Two.

RESOLVE

To provide for the Payment of Sums Due from the Commonwealth to Volunteer Soldiers and Sailors who served in the Spanish War.

1 *Resolved*, That the treasurer of the Commonwealth is
2 hereby authorized to pay out of the treasury of the Com-
3 monwealth all unpaid checks given by the treasurer of the
4 Commonwealth to volunteers in the military or naval ser-
5 vice of the United States during the Spanish war, in
6 accordance with chapter five hundred and sixty-one of the
7 acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-eight, and
8 the amendments thereof, which were not presented for
9 payment within the time prescribed by chapter one hun-
10 dred and seventeen of the acts of the year nineteen hun-
11 dred.
