AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Compensation and Expenses of the Ballot Law Commission.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The sums hereinafter mentioned
2 are appropriated, to be paid out of the treasury
3 of the Commonwealth, from the ordinary revenue,
4 for the purposes specified, to meet expenses for
5 the year ending on the thirty-first day of Decem-
6 ber, nineteen hundred and two, to wit: —

7 For compensation of the ballot law commission,
8 a sum not exceeding fifteen hundred dollars.
9 [Rev. Laws, chap. 11, sect. 157.]

(Appropriation 1901, \$1,500.)

10 For such expenses of the ballot law commission
11 as may be necessary, a sum not exceeding two
12 hundred and fifty dollars. [Rev. Laws, chap. 11,
13 sect. 157.]

(Appropriation 1901, \$500.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
