

HOUSE No. 446.

[Bill accompanying the petition of J. Murray Howe and others for legislation to incorporate them as the Huntington Trust Company with authority to locate in the city of Boston. Banks and Banking. January 29.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Two.

AN ACT

To incorporate the Huntington Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. J. Murray Howe, Thomas Aspinwall,
2 Willis S. Shepard, Richard Fay Parker, Joseph B.
3 Crocker, Henry A. Jenks and Frank Lawrence Blood,
4 their associates and successors are hereby made a corpo-
5 ration named the Huntington Trust Company.

1 SECTION 2. Said corporation shall have authority to
2 establish and maintain a safe deposit and trust company
3 in the city of Boston and shall have all the powers and
4 privileges and be subject to all the duties, liabilities and
5 restrictions set forth in all general laws which are now
6 or may hereafter be in force relating to such corporations.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
