AN ACT

Relative to the Sale of Renovated Butter.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section forty-eight of chapter fifty-six of
2 the Revised Laws is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 herewith are hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
