

HOUSE No. 596.

[Bill accompanying the petition of Charles L. Dean, mayor, for legislation to authorize the sale or exchange of certain land taken for public park purposes in the city of Malden. Cities. January 31.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Two.

AN ACT

To authorize the Sale or Exchange of Certain Land taken for Public Park Purposes in the City of Malden.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The board of park commissioners of the
2 city of Malden are hereby authorized to sell the whole or
3 any portion of a strip of land on the easterly side of the
4 park in Malden, known as Huntings field, not exceed-
5 ing one hundred feet in width, and extending from
6 Salem street to the southerly line of said park, or to
7 exchange said strip of land or any portion thereof for
8 other land now abutting on said park. Said strip is
9 bounded and described as follows:—northerly by the
10 southerly line of Salem street; easterly by the easterly

11 line of said park ; southerly by the southerly line of said
12 park ; and westerly by a line drawn parallel to the east-
13 erly line of said park, and one hundred feet westerly
14 therefrom.

1 SECTION 2. The proceeds of any sale or sales author-
2 ized by this act, shall be paid into the city treasury to
3 be expended by said park commission, when appropri-
4 ated by the city council, for any of the purposes author-
5 ized in chapter one hundred and seventy-seven of the
6 acts of eighteen hundred and ninety-nine, and acts in
7 amendment thereof or in addition thereto.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
