Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Two.

AN ACT

To incorporate the Jamaica Savings Bank.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Thomas L. Livermore, Thomas G. Plant,  
2 Rudolph F. Haffenreffer, Arthur A. Maxwell, John J.  
3 Cantwell, Michael J. Murray, William M. Clark, J.  
4 Albert Brackett, Gustave Magnitzky, Andrew J. Peters,  
5 Joseph B. Gould, John Duff, John Roessle and Thomas  
6 D. Roberts, their associates and successors, are hereby  
7 made a corporation by the name of the Jamaica Savings  
8 Bank, with authority to establish and maintain a savings  
9 bank in some part of the city of Boston formerly Rox-  
10 bury or West Roxbury, with all the powers and privi-  
11 leges and subject to all the duties, liabilities and restrictions  
12 set forth in all general laws now or hereafter in force  
13 relating to savings banks and institutions for savings.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
