[Resolve accompanying the petition of Charles N. Gardner for legislation to provide for a survey and estimate as to the advisability and cost of improving Musquashiat Pond in the town of Scituate, and opening the same to Massachusetts Bay. Harbors and Public Lands. February 3.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Two.

RESOLVE

To provide for a Survey and Estimate by the Harbor and Land Commissioners for the Cost of improving Musquashiat Pond, in the Town of Scituate.

1 *Resolved*, That the board of harbor and land commis-
2 sioners is hereby directed to make, or cause to be made,
3 an investigation, survey and estimate as to the advisability
4 and cost of developing an entrance to Musquashiat pond
5 in the town of Scituate, and of erecting barriers for the
6 protection of the beach in that vicinity, together with
7 any dredging which may in their opinion be necessary,
8 in order to provide a harbor of refuge, as well as gener-
9 ally improving the location. Said board shall make a
10 report upon these matters forthwith, and may expend for
11 the purposes of this resolve a sum not exceeding five
12 hundred dollars which shall be charged to the treasury of
13 this Commonwealth.
