In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Two.

AN ACT

To amend Chapter Seventy-six of the Revised Laws relative to the Practice of Medicine.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section nine of chapter seventy-six o
2 the Revised Laws is hereby amended as follows: strike
3 out in lines twenty and twenty-one in said section "if
4 they do not violate any of the provisions of section eight"
5 and substitute therefor: — if they do not append to their
6 names the letters M.D. or use the title of doctor, meaning
7 thereby, doctor of medicine."

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
