AN ACT

Relative to the Powers of Boards of Health of Cities and  
Towns.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter twenty-five of the Revised Laws  
2 is hereby amended by inserting a new section after sec-  
3 tion fourteen, which shall read as follows:—

4 *Section 15.* Nothing in section fourteen, in relation to  
5 the powers given to towns to make contracts for the dis-  
6 posal of garbage, shall be construed as affecting the powers  
7 of the boards of health as set forth in chapter seventy-  
8 five of the Revised Laws; and the said boards of health  
9 shall have the same powers, in respect to acts done by  
10 persons or corporations acting under authority of chap-  
11 ters twenty-five and twenty-six of the Revised Laws, which  
12 they would have if the said acts were done without such  
13 authority.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
