[Bill accompanying the petition of Edward A. Willard and another] for legislation to increase the salaries of the assistant clerk of the Superior Court for the county of Suffolk. Public Service. February 4.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Two.

AN ACT

To establish the Salaries of the First and Second Assistant Clerks of the Superior Court for the County of Suffolk.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The salary of the first assistant clerk of
2 the superior court for the county of Suffolk shall be
3 thirty-eight hundred dollars a year, to be so allowed
4 from the first day of January, nineteen hundred and two.

1 SECTION 2. The salary of the second assistant clerk
2 of the superior court for the county of Suffolk shall be
3 thirty-three hundred dollars a year, to be so allowed
4 from the first day of January, nineteen hundred and two.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon it pas-
